
Martinique boat show is THE caribbean boat show!

After a successful first edition in 2019, the Martinique Boat Show was suspended for two years due to the pandemic. It signed its return in 2022, confirming the enthusiasm generated by the 1st edition. Attendance up 40%, 35% for the number of exhibitors!

Guadeloupe, Saint-Martin and France were also represented: 14% of exhibitors in 2022 came from outside our island.



The Martinique boat show: a nautical exhibition space on land and afloat!

The Martinique Boat Show takes place for the 3rd time at the Marina of Etang Z'Abricots in Fort-de-France. This unique place put at disposal by the CACEM (Communauté d'Agglomération Centre) allows us to propose to the exhibitors and to the visitors:

- 5000 m² of exhibition space on land
- 200 linear meters of exhibition space afloat


